

Duties of the CMPS President

The President shall have general supervision of the Executive Board; shall appoint a Secretary-Treasurer, a Newsletter Editor, a web master and a Regular Member to chair each standing committee specified in Article VIII, Section 1 of the Bylaws; shall appoint a member of the Executive Board to serve as a liaison between the Section and the host Chapter for the Annual Section Meeting; shall be, ex-officio, a member of all committees except the Nominations and Elections Committee; and may represent the Section or appoint alternate representatives to other Sections, Chapters, or Society boards, committees or meetings.

In even numbered years the President-Elect succeeds to the Office of President for a 2-year term, after which a 1-year term as Past-President is served, for a total of 4 years.
