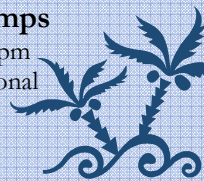




## Club Keiki — Night Camps

Children who are visibly ill will not be admitted.

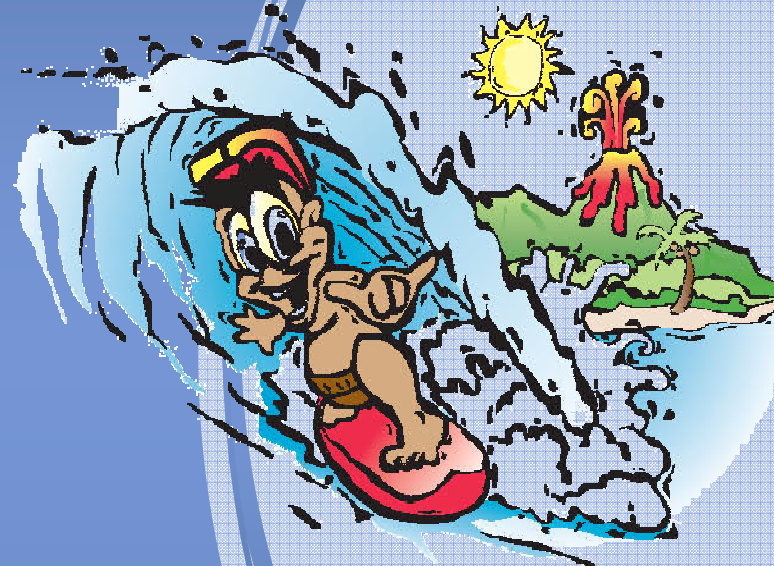
Club Keiki accommodates children with special needs.
